A Photo Exhibit



Commemorating 60 years of Dispossession

This Photo Exhibit is an awareness building resource and is currently being used in several countries to educate and inspire advocacy. It is an expansion of the 1998 book and photo exhibit produced by Sabeel Ecumenical Theology Centre in Jerusalem on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the Nakba. This year the Canadian Friends of Sabeel has reproduced the original exhibit, adding 10 extra photos commemorating the last 10 years of the continuing Nakba experience of the Palestinian people.

Our Story serves as an excellent short or long-term exhibit in libraries, universities, houses of worship, civic halls, as well as a background display for speaker events, conference and workshops. The 60th anniversary version of the exhibit consists of 82 laminated poster boards each measuring 16 x 20 inches. There are 61 photo boards and 21 text boards with titles and text of the past 60 years of the Palestinian story.

The Washington Interfaith Alliance for Middle East Peace (WIAMEP) owns a copy of the photo exhibit and is making it available to borrow within the DC metro area, free of charge.
